A Note from Pastor Debbie

Let us sing a new song. Because our God is a great God and God has done marvelous things.

God has blessed Oakland Presbyterian Church in so many ways, down through the decades – since 1858! And God will continue to lead Oakland into the future.

The Session, Staff and Mission Study Team met on the afternoon of March 12 with Elizabeth Hamilton from Holy Cow Consulting to review the results of the congregational survey which you completed in February. We had 108% of the worshipping congregation (based on average in-person worship attendance) complete the survey. Excellent participation which indicates that this family of faith is engaged and cares about the future of Oakland Presbyterian Church! The Mission Study Team will take this nearly 30 page report and summarize it to share with the congregation. We will share what the data showed and what Elizabeth interpreted for us. (In other words, we will not put "our spin" on this information but try to condense it to make it more accessible to you.) The Mission Study Team will meet after Easter to begin this summary work. We hope to be able to invite you to lunch after worship one of the first Sundays in June to share this important information. Stay tuned! Oakland is a diverse family of faith and we need to use that diversity to strengthen our congregation and enable us to grow. Elizabeth asked the leadership "Why do you want to grow?" And the immediate response, with which we all agreed, was to share the good news of Jesus Christ with our community." I will keep you informed as we make this journey of faith together!

And I want to invite you to join our Thursday night Bible Study at 7 pm. We will complete our study of the Exodus – A People in Transition (sound familiar?) in April. Beginning the first Thursday in May, we will begin a study of the Book of Acts – the story of how God's Holy Spirit blew through and among the early Christian Church. We have fabulous conversation so I hope you will come join us. Also, the Thursday Bible Study participants will be leading our Seder Worship on Maundy Thursday, April 6 at 7 pm in the Fellowship Hall. My prayer and hope are that we will connect the biblical stories of faith with the story of Oakland Presbyterian Church. The biblical witness will provide a foundation for our present experiences. Come join us!

I look forward to journeying with you through Holy Week and worshipping the Risen Lord with you on Easter morning – at 6:30 and 10:30 am! O sing to the Lord a new song!

The First Sunrise Service

As most of you know our former ministers were yoked with three churches; Oakland, White Memorial and Mount Pleasant.

The first Sunrise Service was held at Mount Pleasant in 1954. Rev. Galen Elliott was minister at that time. It was decided that the service would alternate at the other churches in the future.

In 1955, Oakland had its first Sunrise Service. Members of the congregation and the other churches were invited to attend. The Service was most impressive as the combined choirs of the three churches marched out of the church singing while grouped together facing the sunrise. An inspirational message was delivered by Rev. Elliott. Following the service, choir members and other guests served themselves coffee and donuts which had been prepared by the Women of the Church. As they sipped their coffee, they listened to a recording of the service just held. It was thrilling to hear the music and sermon again as well as the birds in the treetops that chirped so loudly while Rev. Elliott delivered the sermon.




Easter Morning

(secretary@oaklandpresbyterianchurch.org) if you know of a need and she will get you in touch with the right person.






Serve Night

The current study is Exodus and starting May 4th, Pastor Debbie will be studying the book of Acts.




Save the Date
